USEFUL VOCABULARY

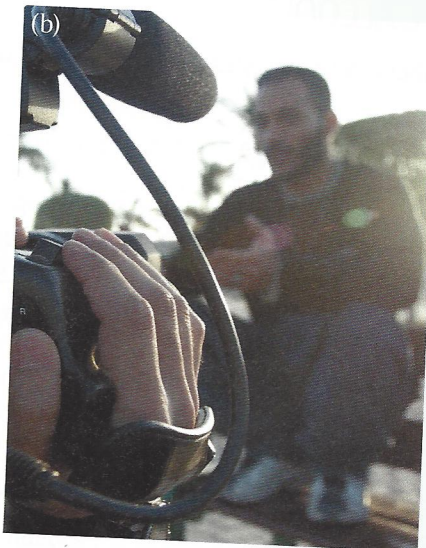

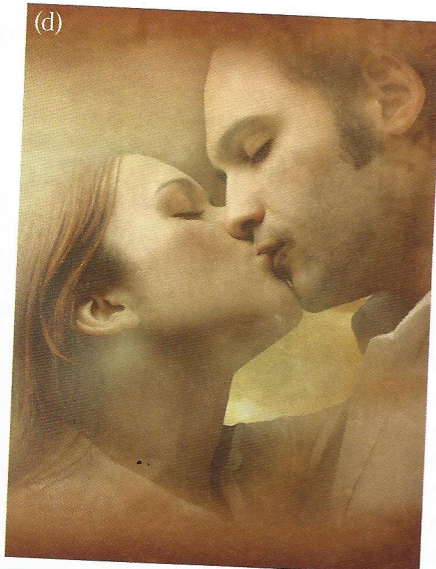

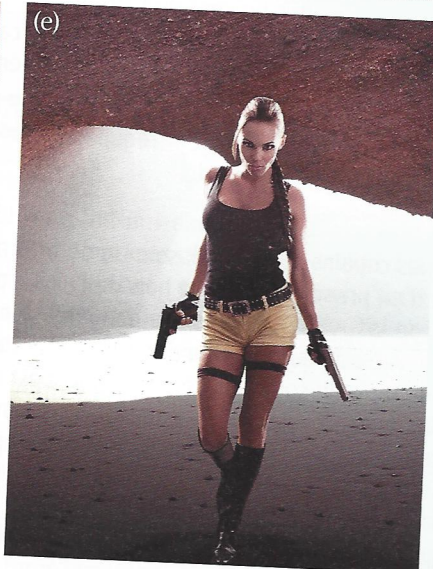
