How to make

## Thor's Hammer







## For the Hammer:

- ► An old box
- ▶ 1 kitchen roll/tube
- Silver foil or paper, or silver paint
- Scissors
- ▶ Glue & Tape

## For the Armlets:

- ▶ 2 kitchen rolls
- Silver foil
- Scissors & glue



## for the **Hammer**

- ► Tape shut the lid/opening of the box.
- Draw round one end of the tube in the centre of the box and then cut or poke a hole there.
- Cut some silver paper or foil to a rough size.
- Spread glue all over the box





- Fold or wrap the paper or foil around the box to cover it all.
- If you are using kitchen foil it will easily fold round the shape and won't need much glue.
- Alternatively, if you are using paint, just paint the whole box silver or grey and leave to dry.



You can use sellotape to seal up the corners if needed.


Once your box is fully covered you can poke through the hole with a pencil or scissor ends, then cut out the hole shape.



- Push the tube into the hole right to the bottom of the box.
- You can secure it with a little sellotape around the hole if needed.








Now cut them to the size that fits your arms.



Draw a straight line with a ruler up each kitchen roll.

Cut up the line with scissors.



- Cut a length of kitchen foil to roughly the same height as your tubes.
- Spread glue across the foil with a gluestick or with PVA glue and a brush.



Roll each tube across the foil, wrapping it around the tube.

► Tuck the ends of the foil around all the cut edges to finish your armlets.
