Couldn't put Humpty together again.*


### Numeracy

- Symmetry - Find 3 objects in your home or garden that are symmetrical. Some leaves are and some toys like teddy bears are too.  
You could also paint a symmetrical picture by folding a piece of paper in half to make the centre line. Only paint one side of the paper then fold both sides together again to make a symmetrical picture.



### Literacy

- Rhyme - Look out for the rhyming words in Humpty Dumpty. Can you think of anymore rhyming words with the same sound?



Do any of your books rhyme? Listen to Miss Lawson's reading of Ten Little Pirates and try to spot the rhymes in this story.
