Anaphylaxis / Online Training

Anaphylaxis / Online Training

- All staff travelling on the trip have been trained using the aforementioned training and will be on hand if any issues arise - we simply ask that pupils are all made aware.
- The pupil attending is allergic to peas, lupin, lentils, sesame, soybeans, tree nuts, beans, peanuts, dogs, cats and suffers from hayfever.
- Pupils sharing a room with the pupil should try to avoid taking any food back to the room if possible, all other pupils are asked to just be aware during times such as waiting for the bus to arrive.
