Dear Parents,

PUPIL EQUITY AND MAINLAND RESIDENTIAL SCHOOL TRIPS – CONSULTATION RESULTS

I refer to my letter dated 18th September 2017 which related to pupil equity in respect of mainland residential school trips, where I consulted with parents on the provision they would like to see in the school.

I asked parents to consider whether they would prefer to keep the current cycle of residential school trips to every two years and to change the target group to Primary 6 and Primary 7 pupils or whether they would prefer to change the cycle of residential school trips to every three years and keep the target group to Primary 5, Primary 6 and Primary 7 pupils.

I asked parents to inform the school office by 22nd September 2017 as to what their preference was.

The result of this consultation was overwhelmingly in favour of keeping the cycle of school trips to every two years as it is currently, but changing the target group of children eligible to attend.

Fourteen out of seventeen families responded and of these thirteen families opted for a two year cycle of school trips with only Primary 6 and 7.

Three families did not respond.

As this response is so clear cut, **I can now confirm to parents that residential mainland school trips will be offered to children every two years with Primary 6 and 7 eligible to attend.**

I would like to thank all those who completed and returned their consultation responses to the school office. I have included all responses which were received up until today.

I hope that we can now move forward with some planning for a residential trip in the future and look forward to working with the Parent Council on this.
