The school is proposing to make some small changes to the school's start time and the structure of the school day. We want to seek the opinions of parents about our proposal before proceeding with any changes.

The Proposal

- Move the school's start time by 10 minutes to 8.50am.
- Make small changes break and lunch time to divide the day into three equal parts.

Session One - 8.50am to 10.30am
Morning Break - 10.30am to 10.50am
Session Two - 10.50am to 12.30pm
Lunch Break - 12.30pm to 1.20pm
Session Three - 1.20pm to 3.00pm

Why?

- Unify the start time for the school and Sgoil Araich to 8.50am to make parent drop-off easier.
- Reduce instances of pupil lateness. (217 instances of pupil lateness recorded in the last school year)
- Improve timetabling by having a school day of three equal sessions.

Notes

- There will be no changes made to the school bus times.
- The school day would continue to end at 3.00pm.
- Lunch break would be shortened to 50 minutes.
