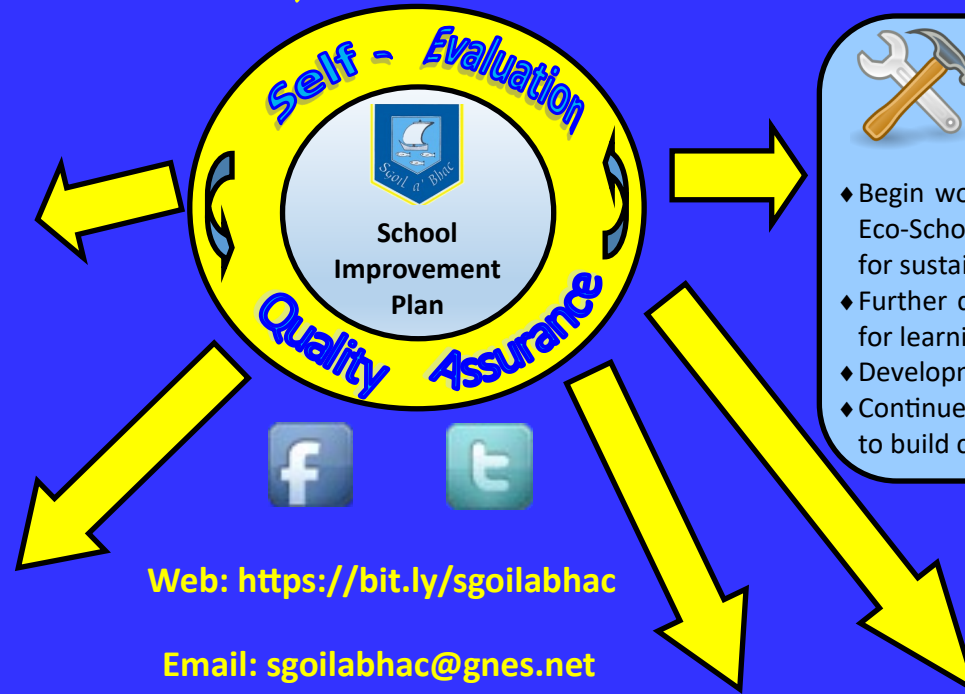

Developing STEM Education

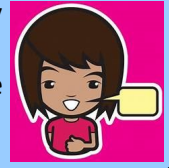
- ◆ Develop skilled practitioners who can effectively collaboratively plan and deliver STEM subjects.
