



Thank you for your interest in taking part in e-Cèilidh nan Òg.

Please read the following information and then follow the steps below to contribute

e-Cèilidh nan Òg is open to all primary pupils in both EM & GM classes in the Western Isles and will take place during the day on Friday 29th May (times TBC) as part of the 'Dèanamaid Dihaoine – Let's Do It Friday' programme of events. The event will take the form of broadcasts, hosted by local music teachers, using pre-recorded items contributed by pupils, covering each of the categories below. The event will also include 2 sing-along and play-along sessions during the day for any pupils who would like to take part but who perhaps do not wish to send in a video performance.

- All contributed items will be pre-recorded videos and pupils are invited to submit items in the following categories:
 - **Gaelic Singing**
 - **Oral** eg, poetry, storytelling, bible reading etc
 - **Instrumental** - Fiddle, whistle, accordion, melodeon, guitar, keyboard, clarsach, chanter, bagpipes or any other instrument.
 - **Highland Dancing**
- All items are own choice.
- Vocal & oral items must be in Gaelic.
- Instrumental items must be of Scottish traditional music.
- Dancing items can be any traditional highland dance.
- A maximum of one item from each category can be submitted
- The following technical specification is recommended for items:
 - ♪ Any means of video recording, including smartphone or tablet, preferably set to 720p @ 30 fps and filmed in landscape format.
 - ♪ Maximum duration of each item – 4 minutes.
- Recordings should also include the following at the beginning if possible:
 - ♪ Your name
 - ♪ Which school you attend and which class you are in
 - ♪ Title of what they are playing/singing/saying/dancing
