Pupils shared the message of how large quantities of iron railings in Scotland were removed for re-use during the war but how Stornoway was unaffected by this making it unique in still have iron railings. They also shared all their learning connected to the Herring Girls - clothing worn when travelling, different types of stitches and knitting patterns each of the Herring Girls had from their own local area. They also shared the artwork they've produced throughout the project. The class then entertained everyone by performing a song they had learned, *Rionnag as an Oidhche Fhrasaich*. It was fantastic to see all the rich learning the pupils have engaged in connected to our local culture and heritage.
