






Caitlyn, Fraya and Grace enjoyed visiting Kyle and joining in a range of activities. They had fun reading stories in the tent.

P4-7 EM Class Charter 2019

Children respect these rights by:

- Article 31—You have the right to rest and play and to have the chance to join in a wide range of activities.
- Article 29—Schools should help children develop their skills and personality fully.
- Article 12—You have a right to speak up and have your opinions listened to and taken seriously by adults on things that affect you.
- Article 28—You have the right to an education.

Adults respect these rights by:

- Article 31—Show good timing of lessons
- Article 29—Take a brain break if necessary
- Article 12—Give a wide range of activities and lessons
- Article 28—Let children be themselves
- Article 31—Spend time with all children
- Article 29—Give children time to practice
- Article 12—Encourage a growth mindset
- Article 28—Listen to or give time to listen to children later
- Article 12—Not getting cross with anyone for giving their opinion
- Article 28—Respect children's opinions
- Article 31—Explain things carefully and listen
- Article 29—Spread time out between all the children
- Article 12—Make sure the work is not too hard or too easy
