Welcome to another of our class blogs! You have all been super busy while I have been away and I was met with this super share on Monday morning!



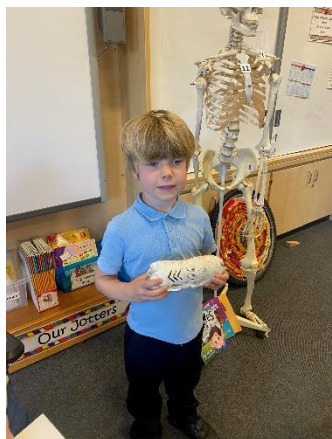
Autumn has visited the library and found this great book on the body. It is full of interesting facts – including things like why sugar tastes sweet and why we burp...

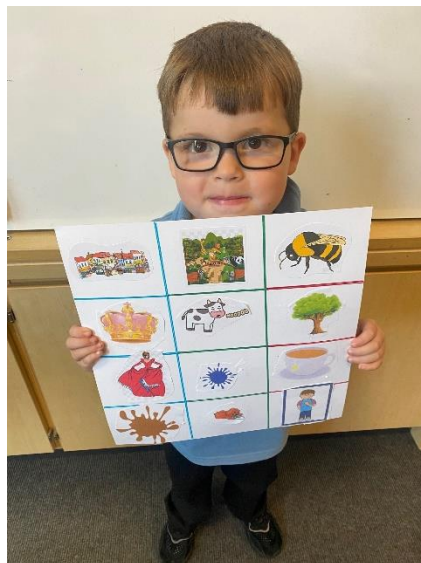


This continued into an afternoon session as we put our ideas to percussion and created a little performance....

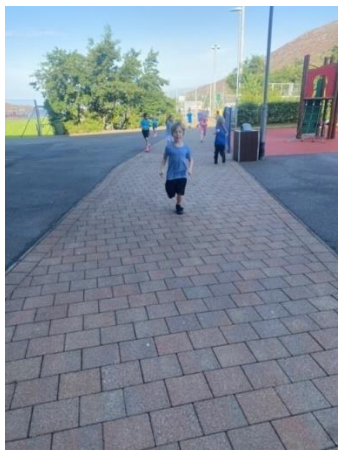
These children are on tippy toes as they work on the ladder – Logan, Brooke, Darcey and George! Followed by Cooper, Phoenix and Autumn!



Fantastic power jumps through the hoops – Rowan, Robert, Cooper and Phoenix!



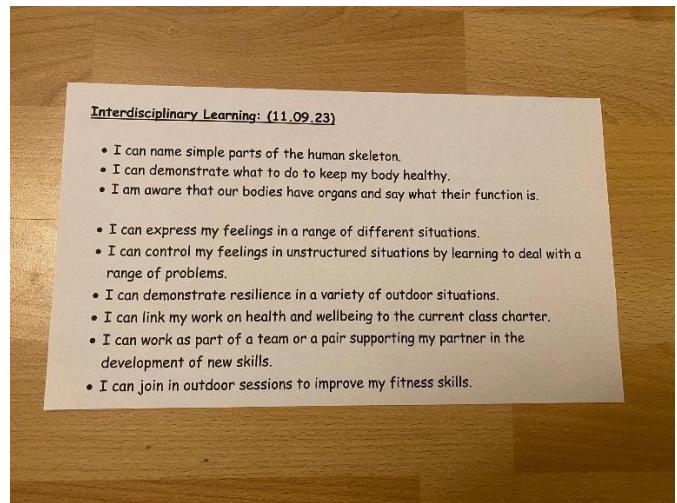
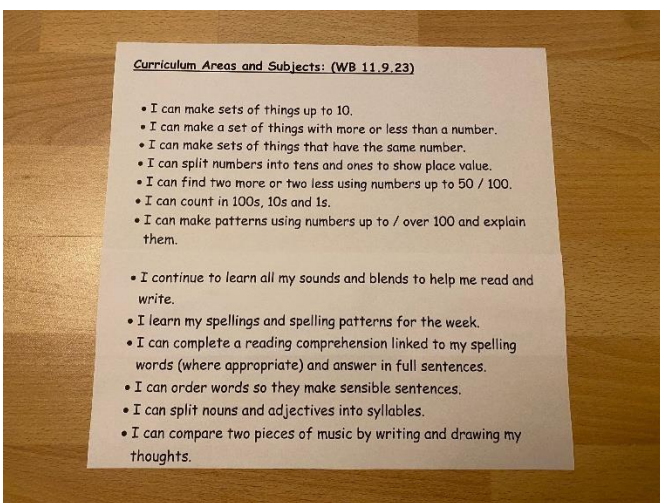
On running form this week are..... Zoe, Rowan, Robert and George!
