This I believe is Logan....ah there he is! Robert is gaining confidence in the large pool and he's working with a float!



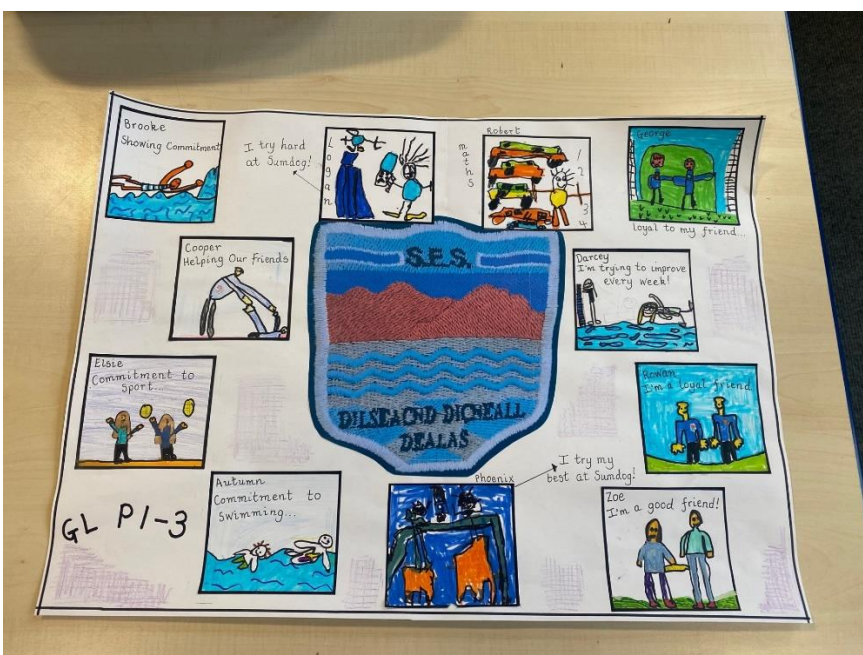
You would think these dumbbells should weigh you down.... In fact, they help you float! Here's Zoe, Phoenix, Brooke and Cooper!

More awards again this week! And all achieved before 9.00am!

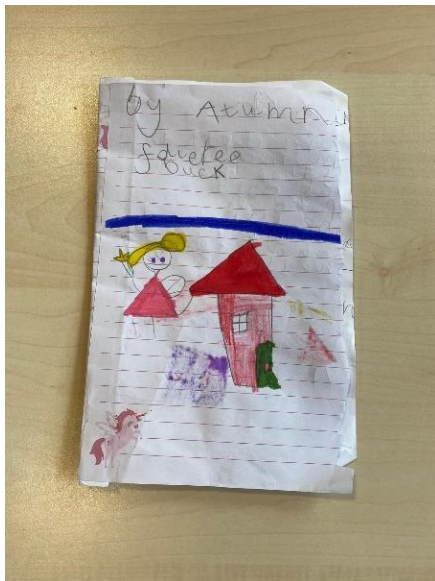
This time it's congratulations to Rowan Sixsmith who has achieved his 5x table award!

Gaelic Music:

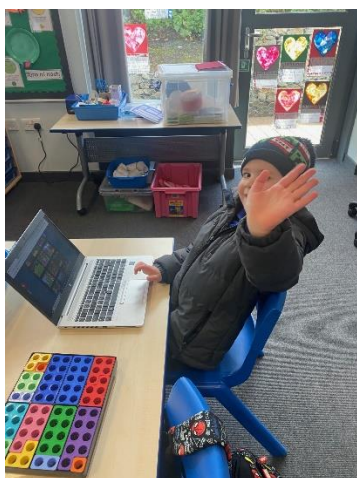


I think we gave it everything we'd got on Thursday afternoon!
