Elmer the Elephant:

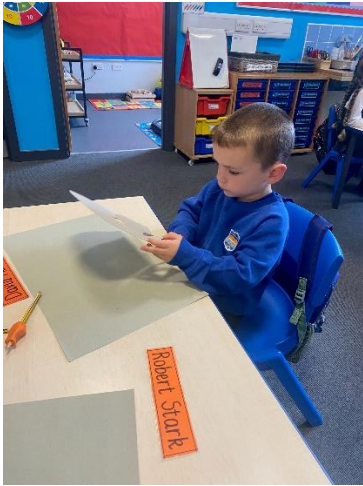


This wonderful story by David McKee will be a great start to our topic work!

Paddy was very impressed with our phonic shoot. He said each word carefully, before posting the card in the box! We were impressed too, Paddy!

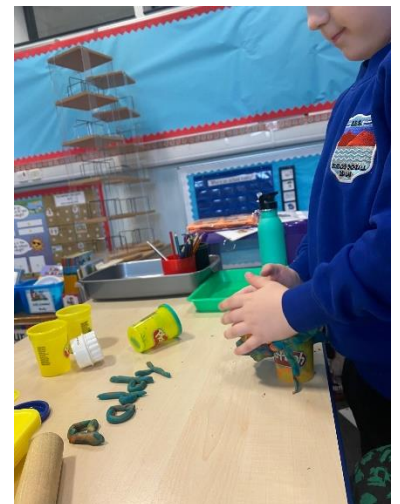
