We finished with some dribbling games... here's some throw-ins from Zoe, Brooke and Rowan – and a stop from Logan! Well done, everyone!


Our Favourite Activities – term one plus floorbook!

He had been busy on his tasks this week and chose his own sticker for his folder – well done, Paddy!


Maths:

We are finishing off this term's topic in style! We have been busy making Elmer the elephant from multilink cubes... it was rather tricky!


























...and our Elmer day on the last day...
