Welcome to another blog from P1-4. Let's start with some fantastic news!




Here's George with a silver award for his 2,3,4,5 and 10 times tables mixed bag!

Our writing continues! The children continue to work super hard on their ambitious words! It's equally fun keeping track of our group scores on the run charts!






























Book Week Workshop:












We were delighted to welcome Louisa MacDougall into school to read one of her stories.

Christmas Choir:




We have three new recruits for the Christmas choir!

Darcey, Brooke and Logan are working hard on their musical skills and I'm delighted they have decided to join up!


Well done – and keep trying!
