It's another award for Elsie!


This time she has nailed her mixed bag of tables -2,3,4,5,6,7 and 10 times tables! That is just excellent news, isn't it?

Pop-up books generated quite a bit of interest this week, as did texture books and non-fiction books! You just never know what you'll find in Tarbert Library!









### **Next Learning Block:**
