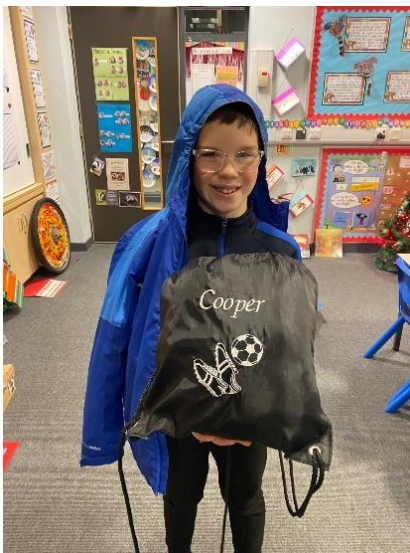
Cooper completes our Advent tree for this year with bag number 20!
