<p>Fairyland:</p> <p>During topic work, children will explore traditional fairytales with a focus on character, plot and setting. Pupils will develop their higher order thinking skills through a range of activities through the context of fairytale. Through drama, children will also explore character movement and body language.</p> <p>Play Pedagogy</p> <p>Pupils will be provided with opportunity to learn through play, during maths and literacy activities. Once weekly, pupils will participate in play through a context of learning such as special/significant events in the year e.g. Burns Nights.</p> <p>Outdoor Learning</p> <p>Pupils will engage in outdoor education play regularly.
