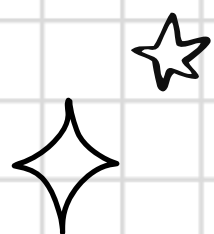

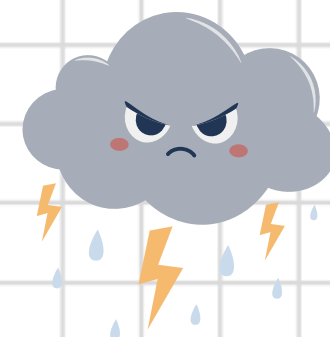
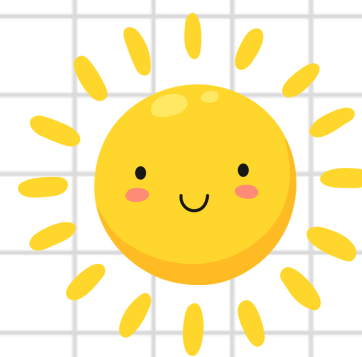

# INTERDISCIPLINARY LEARNING



## OUR GLOBAL WORLD

This term, our IDL topic is Our Global World. As part of this topic, the children will be learning about extreme weather and natural events around the world, including storms, hurricanes, floods, droughts and other extreme conditions.

We will explore where and why these events happen, how they can affect people, communities and the environment and how different parts of the world prepare for and respond to extreme weather.

The topic will give pupils opportunities to develop their skills across Social Studies, Science, Literacy and Technologies, while helping them to build a greater understanding of the world beyond their own community.

## HOMEWORK

### Homework

Each week, pupils are asked to:

- Reading: Read their reading book 3–4 times.
- Gàidhlig spelling: Five Gàidhlig spelling words will be given each Monday. These will be assessed the following Monday.
- English spelling: Five English spelling words will be given each Friday and assessed the following Friday.
