



## **Literacy Strategy**

In August 2024, teachers and SMT met during Collegiate time to discuss what teaching resources were available to support learning and teaching in both Gàidhlig Medium and Gaelic Learners classes. The following list was created to act as a starting point for teaching staff (including supply staff and teachers new to the school) on what resources are currently being used within our school. At all stages and across both GM and GL classes, teachers must be led by the Curriculum for Excellence Experiences & Outcomes and Progression Frameworks as well as their understanding of individual pupils' current levels and next steps in learning, backed by robust assessment evidence. This will be achieved through the school's Forward Planning measures, Assessment Calendar and 'On Track to Achieve' termly meetings.

A formal Learning, Teaching and Assessment policy will be created for Sgoil Ùige during Session 24-25 and this strategy will make up part of that document. In all cases, Literacy lessons will follow the principles of 'High Quality Learning and Teaching' as identified by the Northern Alliance Learning, Teaching and Assessment Toolkit:
