

### **A VERY busy June!**

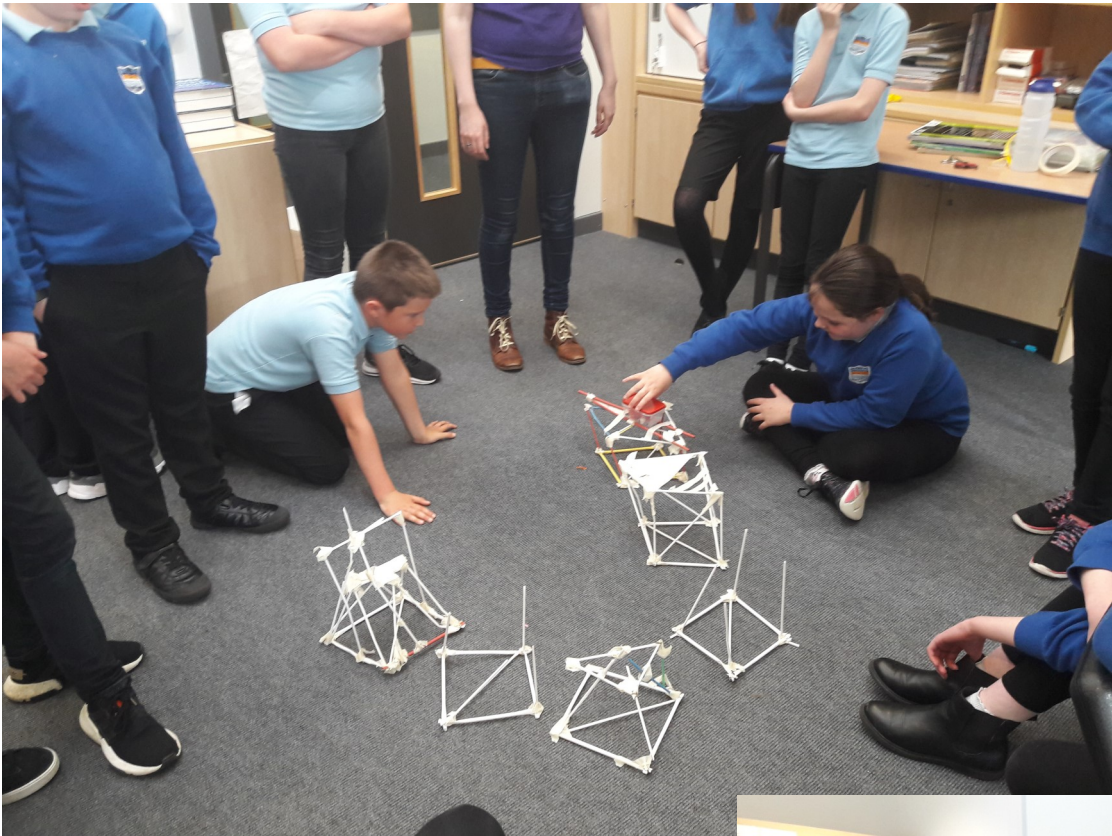
We have been so busy in P4-7 in June we have hardly had time to keep up with our blog, so lets get started with all our news.
