## The Stages

- & We discussed what we wanted our library to look at feel like (adjectives).
- We decided what theme we wanted to design and got into groups with people who wanted to do the same theme.
- & Design theme research search engines like Google images.
- We created a design plan for our theme (birds eye view and 3D design plan).
- & Planned our presentations scripts.
- & Class conference we did a presentation in our groups to try and 'sell' our design theme.
