Self-Harm Network Scotland

- Penumbra is a pioneering mental health charity that has supported people who self-harm for over
 25 years
- In 2021 we applied to the Scottish Governments recovery and renewal fund to further develop our work
- Working with the Scottish Government team we launched Self-Harm Network Scotland at the end of 2022. These are pilot services which will contribute to the Scottish Governments Self-Harm Strategy.

Our Aims

- To provide a compassionate and freely accessible support services to people who self-harm, embedding the principles of peer support and 'time, space, compassion'
- To provide relevant resources, information and tools to professionals, loved ones and supported people to enable recovery and improved response to self-harm
- To embed and advocate for lived experience at all levels of the service and the strategy

We offer free self-harm awareness training to professionals across Scotland, both online and in person. Sessions can be delivered for:

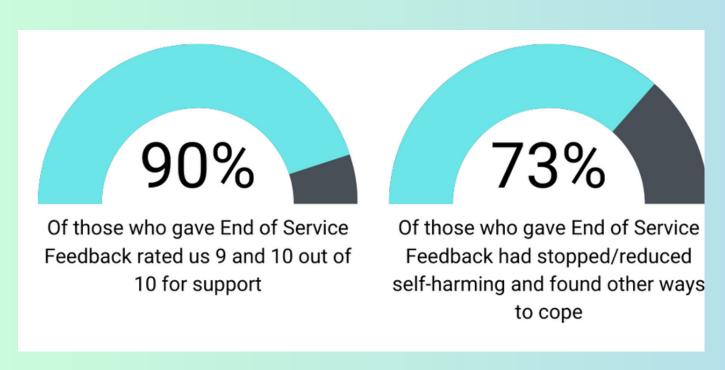
Services - Locality Support



We have 3 Locality Services delivering in-person 1:1 support in the following areas in Scotland:

- Dundee: Working with young people aged 12-18
- Glasgow: Working with people 16+
- Highlands & Islands: Working with people 16+

We offer flexible, person centred support which can be delivered in 1:1 sessions with one of our peer practitioners. We also engage with local communities to provide information, access to support and community engagement opportunities.



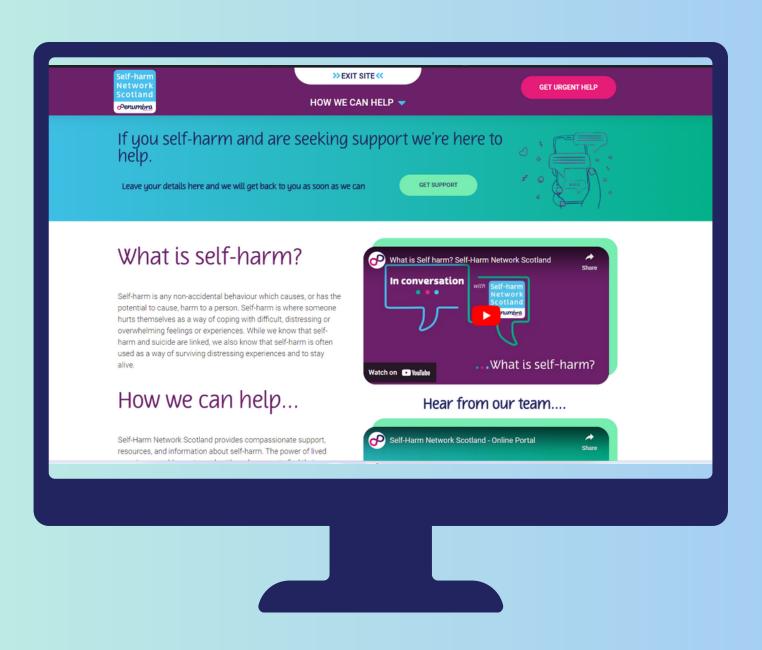
