

Safer Injecting Advice

Sharing equipment puts you at enormous risk of contracting blood borne viruses such as Hepatitis or HIV.

Ensure injecting equipment is new and unused. Share nothing, including spoons. Ensure equipment is returned for safe disposal.

Overdose Awareness

Mixing drugs or using more drugs than you normally would can result in an accidental overdose.

Naloxone is a medicine which can reverse the effects of an opioid overdose for a short time and can save lives. If you give someone Naloxone you must also call an ambulance as the Naloxone will only reverse effects for a short time. Recognising the signs of overdose: Deep Snoring Slurred speech Loss of consciousness Shallow breathing Call 999
