The courses are also ideal for older young people who are considering a career in the performing or production arts, hoping to study with us or another institution full-time, or are simply looking for a fantastic creative learning experience.

Young people age 17 or older are also able to apply for our adult summer schools.

Participants will work in the same rehearsal rooms, dance studios and performance spaces that we use for our degree programmes.

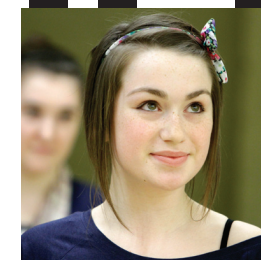
