



Aberdour Primary School – Homework Strategy

Following feedback from parents in session 23-24 we worked collaboratively with a group of parents to create a more consistent approach to homework. If you and your child complete homework tasks, then these will be marked, and feedback will be given by your child's class teacher.

All children from Primary 2 – Primary 7 will be given a homework jotter at the start of the session, Primary 1s will initially be given a sound book (further information on this is shared at the Primary 1 Curriculum Evening in late August every session).

The way the grids are designed ensures they align to the learning your child is engaging in in class. For example, if they are working on Time in class there are Time homework activities for your child to complete. In spelling the activities can be applied to any spelling pattern. As there are many activities to choose from across any one level, it ensures there is plenty of choice for children. In reading the activities cover a variety of text types your child may be engaging in in class including Fiction, Non-Fiction and Poetry texts.

The grids are progressive as follows:-

Early level activities – Predominantly completed by children in Primary 1

First level activities - Predominantly completed by children in Primary 2-4

Second level activities - Predominantly completed by children in Primary 5-7

Third level activities – Some children in Primary 7
