
Balmerino Primary School P4-7 Pupil Feedback March 2020

Almost everyone (96%) agreed with this: When I have been learning from home, I have known how to find my work on Teams


Almost everyone (90%) agreed or mostly agreed with this: When I have been learning from home, I have understood what to do for my tasks. The remaining 10% said it was sometimes true – no one said they never knew what to do.


What ways has your teacher used to show you how to do your tasks:





When I have been learning from home, I have asked my teacher for help by:





Most people (86%) agreed with this: When I have been learning from home, I have got help from my teacher when I asked for it. The rest told us they had never needed to ask for help.

Almost everyone (96%) agreed with this: When I have been learning from home, I have been able to keep in touch with others in my class.

Most people (73%) agreed with this: When I have been learning from home, I have had help from school when I needed it. The rest told us they had never needed to ask for help.

People gave these examples of what has been good about learning from home:

- More time to play outside
- Having choice over when I do my work/going at my own pace
- Taking a break when I want
- Learning to work independently
- Learning to work online/with Teams
- Having video calls
- Its quieter and that helps me concentrate

People gave these examples of what could have been better about learning from home?

- No teams/internet problems
- Being in touch with friends more

People gave these examples of what they are looking forward to about coming back to school?

- Seeing friends
- Working with my teacher in person
- PE
- Learning with classmates
