Balmerino Primary School Pupil Survey October 2021

In October 2021, we carried out a Wellbeing survey. It was completed by almost all P4-7s and a representative number of P1-3s. Children were asked to give each statement a score out of 10 – 10 being really true and 1 being not at all true. The results are collated here. Overall, the results give a picture of a school in which pupils feel safe and included and that they feel looked after by the adults in school. While none of the responses give cause for concern, there are some areas which indicate room for improvement and these have been considered in the recent review of Relationship and Behaviour policy as well as in our wider work with individual children.

Pupils scored themselves on a 1 to 10 scale for each statement. 1 being strongly disagree, 10 being strongly agree.
