

Balmerino Primary School Target Setting and Sharing Learning Survey 2021/22

In December 2021 and again in May 2022, parents were asked to rate 10 statements using 10 stars: One star means not at all true for me, Five or Six stars mean neither true nor untrue for me, Ten stars mean very much true for me.

Following on from the baseline gathered in December 2021, we introduced shared target setting and regular sharing of work on Seesaw. The repeated survey in May 2022 indicates gain against all statements and a development area for 2022/23 to consider how we offer advice to parents to support their child's learning at home.

25 parents completed the survey in December 2021 and 22 in May 2022. This equates to a little below half the number of parents in the school.
