In 2024-25, Our school improvement priorities were:

- Conceptual Understanding of Numeracy
- Pupils' Progress
- Pupil Voice, Leadership of Learning and Wider Achievement
- Sign-a-long

What we did:

- All teaching staff took part in Conceptual Understanding of Numeracy Training
- All teaching staff became familiar with the new Progress System and used it to record tracking information and write end of year reports
- All P1-7 children took on a leadership role in their committee
- All Nursery children were exposed to sign-a-long and there are examples of pupils being able to lead learning in sharing their signing skills with peers.

What we need to do next:

- Audit maths resources to make sure all classes have access to the right materials to support their understanding of number
- Share the language of maths with our PSA team to develop their skills to support learning
- Audit our Health and Wellbeing planning tools to ensure we are evidencing pupils' progress
- Further develop practice to support children to discuss their learning and plan next steps
- Develop understanding of Meta-Skills language to support pupils to articulate their achievements
