Context of the School

Demographic	As of 23rd June, the P1-7 roll sits at 51 pupils arranged into 3 classes. Projection for 2025-26 is 47 pupils arranged into 2 classes. The nursery roll is 18, 7 of whom will go into P1 in August 2025 and the projected roll for August 2025 is 12, rising to 14 in January. There are no pupils who have a free school meal entitlement through registration. 23% have a factor giving rise to additional support needs. 10% speak a second language in the family home. 99% of the Nursery-P7 cohort live in SIMD 7 and 8.
