- Support effective use of sensory equipment.
- Make classrooms more sensory-friendly.
- Monitor the impact of sensory supports.
- Work with therapists and specialist services.
- Encourage staff to share and develop good practice.
- Create guidance for consistent sensory approaches.



ACTIONS

- Provide iPad training for staff.
- Help staff feel more confident using technology.
- Support staff to use digital tools to promote independence.
- Explore accessibility features to support learning.
- Share good practice and develop staff skills.
- Plan and evaluate the use of technology in learning.
- Explore the use of Showbie across the school.
- Use technology to support pupil voice.
- Review technology resources and how they are being used.
- Monitor the impact of technology on pupil outcomes.
