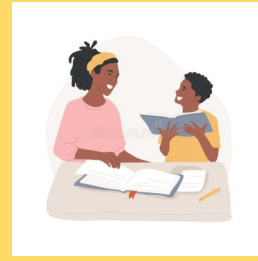
Messages

- **Timekeeping:** We have high expectations at Canongate and we strive to prepare our learners for life beyond education by instilling values that will serve them in the world of work. With that in mind please support your child to attend school at 09:00. Although we appreciate occasionally there are valid reasons for lateness we expect learners to be on time. Late comers cause operational difficulty with ordering of lunches, registration, missing the initial learning activity, disrupting a settled class and importantly starting the child's own day un-settled and missing important learning time.



- **Homework:** Homework has begun to be issued by all classes. As with time keeping, we have high expectations of our learners and appreciate your continued support with completing and returning homework every Tuesday. Homework is issued on a Thursday. Children will have reading days throughout the week and should bring their homework folder to school everyday in their bag. Please note that children are never given material that is not consolidation and should be able to complete tasks independently. We encourage children to think about the timing of homework completion to time manage effectively. In the older classes; parents should not feel that they need to share all of the reading pages but could sample a few pages or a chapter together to support and see progress.



- **15:00 Playground Access:** We encourage families to enjoy our beautiful grounds after school but please remember that all children must be supervised by an adult after 15:00.
