I would like to introduce and welcome our new staff who have joined us at Cardenden:



School Uniform

Please support us with promoting school uniform.

All staff will be discussing uniform with pupils – if they come to school one day in non-uniform, staff will remind them to wear the correct uniform the next day. If on the second day the child is still in non-uniform, class teachers will give parents a call to discuss. We have plenty of spare uniform available for families if this would be helpful.

We will also be encouraging pupils to wear school colours on PE days too (plain school-coloured bottoms, white polo shirt and plain school coloured jumper).

Cost of the School Day

Uniforms, trips, school lunches, gym kits, pencils and pens, and dress down days can be difficult to afford for low-income families. When children and young people can't take part in opportunities because of cost, they miss out and feel excluded, and it is harder for them to learn, achieve and be happy at school.


