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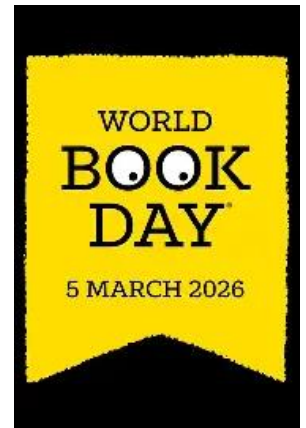
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School Gates Reminder

Book Fayre will be in school next week. All classes will have a chance to visit, and this will be open during Parent Contact appointments too.



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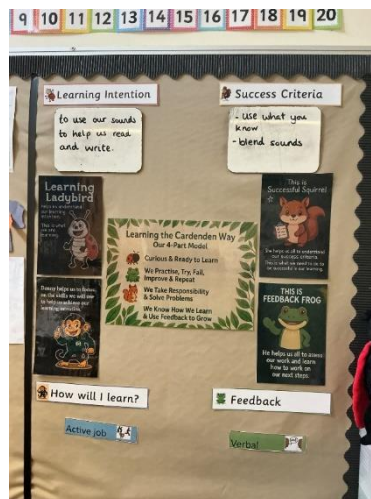
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Learning at Cardenden ... look what's been going on recently!
