Nappy Changing Update

If your child has an accident whilst in nursery, any soiled/wet clothing will be double bagged, labelled and stored until collection time.

When taking the clothes home, parents/carers should:

- Dispose of excess soiling down the toilet.
- Use a prewash function on washing machine to clean the clothes. Soiled clothing should not be rinsed under the tap.
- Wash soiled clothing at the hottest temperature indicated on the care label.

Please note that the toilet in our nursery entrance is a changing area and must not be used by adults. If adults need to use the toilet whilst dropping off or picking up at nursery, they can use the toilet in our main foyer / entrance to school.
