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Child Protection and Safeguarding

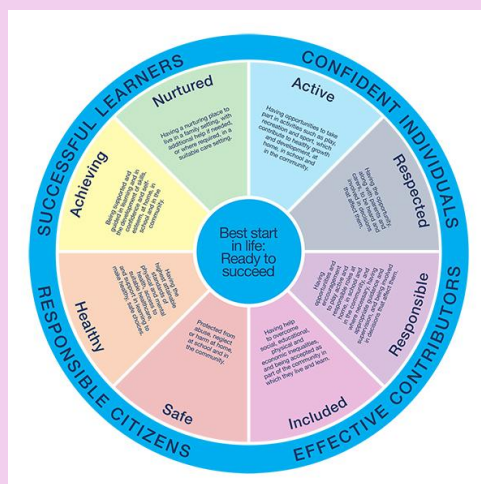
At Cardenden Primary School & Nursery, the safety and wellbeing of every child is our highest priority. As part of our safeguarding responsibilities, all staff are required to record any information that a child shares which may indicate they are at risk of harm or that they need additional support. This includes comments made during conversations, class activities, or play.

Sometimes children disclose information about events at home without fully understanding that what they are describing may be a concern. When this happens, staff have a professional duty to record and share this information with the appropriate safeguarding leads. These records help us build a clear picture of a child's wellbeing and ensure that children and families receive the right support when needed.

We would also like to remind families that physical punishment, including smacking, is illegal in Scotland. The law protects children from physical punishment in the same way that adults are protected, and schools are required to respond appropriately when a child discloses that they have been physically punished.

Our aim is always to work in partnership with parents and carers. In most circumstances, we will discuss concerns with families and seek to provide support wherever possible. Safeguarding is everyone's responsibility, and by working together we can help ensure that every child feels safe, respected, nurtured, and able to thrive.
