Digital Technologies

The Digi Leaders, supported by the school's Digital Ambassadors, have continued to raise the profile of technologies across the school. Staff used the digital road map and plans from last session to begin gathering evidence for the Digital School Award.

Scottish Attainment Fund

The funding continues to support activities and interventions with planned outcomes to improve Literacy, Numeracy and Health and wellbeing.

School Playground

A long term plan has been co-created with families and pupils to develop the school playground. Whole school fundraising at key events and a visible target journey has helped raise the profile and provide ownership to all within the community.
