Aim	How we know we've achieved our aim
Priority 1: Make sure everyone has the skills, resources and support we need to read and spell Develop phonological awareness as a pathway to reading and spelling.	 All pupils experience consistency in routines, classroom provisions and resources to support reading and spelling. Key strategies needed to support phonological awareness/prereading in school and at home are identified Teaching and support staff can identify and implement next steps to develop phonological awareness. Pupils can use Bookbag resources and games and can talk about how this helps them develop their literacy skills.

All pupils can identify a member of staff to talk to, if they need to talk about their wellbeing All pupils are informed on their next steps in learning.
