Attainment Session 22/23

Our low cohort numbers have an impact on our attainment data. As our numbers increase or decrease, this can have a significant impact on our data.

Overall our attainment is at 76% for Literacy and 77% for Numeracy across the school. This means that most of the learners across the school have achieved the national standards expected in Literacy and Numeracy.

Our attendance rate for the school was 92%
