In literacy we are learning to:

- Order words alphabetically.
- Use a dictionary to check the meaning and spelling of a word.
- Some pupils will also begin to use a thesaurus to develop and extend vocabulary.
- Ask and answers literal and evaluative questions about a text.
- Use skimming and scanning to find information, key words and phrases from a longer text.
- Make notes or a plan before writing a new story or text.
- Write to share your own viewpoint and persuade others.
- We will also continue with our visits to Dunfermline Library.

In numeracy & maths we are learning to:

Money

- Identify all UK coins and notes.
- Combine coins and notes to pay for an item.
- Calculate the total amount of more than one item and the change owed back.
- Understand the various methods of paying for goods.
- Record amounts in different ways e.g. 215p = £2.15.
- Some pupils will also learn about the terms: budget, savings, credit, debit and debt.

Measure (Miss Ross)

- Measure weight, volume, length and area.
- Match the correct unit to the measurement.
- Name measuring tools.
- Read from a scale.
- Estimate and compare quantities using 'equal', 'greater than', 'less than' vocabulary.
- Use < and > signs to compare.

In science and social studies we are learning:

Through 'Amazing Animals' we will learn about:

- The habitats and environments that different animals need to survive.
- How climate affects living things.
- How we can care for our local environment and wildlife.
- Food chains and webs.
- How humans and animals use their senses.

In P.E. we will learn how to improve fitness and develop a range of run jump and throw techniques in athletics.

In ICT we are learning to:

- Use a search engine to find information.

- Compare information from different websites and talk about which is a more trustworthy source.
- Use simple shortcut keys to copy and paste information.
- Create a presentation to share information.

In Expressive Arts we are learning to:

Music: Develop rhythm and pitch through games and songs. Play tuned and untuned percussion.

Art: Explore colour theory language and skills such as creating colour wheels, gradients of a colour, tone, warm and cold colours.

Drama: Use voice considering volume, expression, clarity and pace to convey a character. Use movements and gestures to convey a character.
