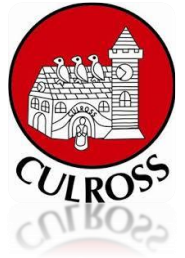

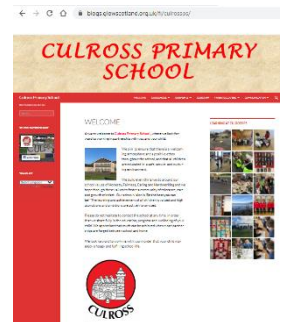
Dear Parent/Carer
