# Improving Reading Outcomes for P7 Learners

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


Stretch Aim: To achieve 92% attainment in Primary 7 reading for academic session 24/25 (Baseline 81%)

**Teaching Aims:** 100% of pupils within the focus group will be able to summarise a text using a who, where, what, why and when method (Baseline: 0%).

#### Method

- Established an Improvement Team.
- Attended Fife QI Improving Reading Programme.
- · Identified a focus group.
- Carried out a baseline assessment against CfE benchmarks.
- The baseline assessment was used to create a pareto chart.
- The biggest challenge for the majority of the children was summarising..
- The pareto chart informed our teaching aims..



### Implement

- Children summarising 3 times per week.
- Teacher input aligned to aim (model summary identifying key information/co-creation of successful summaries)
- Once independent 20 minutes to read the text and summarise the info, (Who? What? Where? Why? When?)
- Self/peer assess and feedback against Success Criteria.
- Pupils track progress.


## Achievements

By 16/12/24, 100% of children within the focus group reached Teaching aim 1.

#### Next steps

- Use process to target those readers who are further off track as a means to try and help further their learning.
- Using this framework, adapt for other areas of the curriculum to try and make further improvements as well as track and monitor the impact of teaching strategies.

#### Conclusions

Refining the operational definition and streamlining the process led to more successful learner outcomes.

Finding a way to implement change in a manner that was both meaningful and manageable was a challenge, but we're glad we persevered as the outcomes were all very positive.

# **Key Learning Points**

- Key shift in results tied in with the introduction of our Summarising
  Starters support sheet.
- More explicit teaching and structure led to more success.
- Keeping things small and measurable allowed for genuine progress.
