Learning will be exciting and relevant, with real-life examples and experiences that help children see the purpose of what they are learning

Ask your child what new projects or themes they are learning about. Show interest and link learning to everyday life.

Every curricular area will be covered with clear progression across Early, First and Second Level through our Proud to Be Me programme. .

Support your child's learning at home through reading, number games, cooking, gardening or trips that connect to their school learning.

Children will learn about sustainability, global goals (SDGs) and their rights (UNCRC).

Share ideas, expertise or resources linked to sustainability or rights. Join workshops/events when invited.

Children will develop creativity, confidence and teamwork skills so they can thrive in learning, in relationships and in their future lives.

Encourage responsibility at home (helping with jobs, problem-solving, teamwork) and celebrate achievements.

Children will see learning that connects school, home and community, with opportunities to learn alongside their families.

Take part in family learning events, curriculum showcases or workshops, and use these to explore learning together with your child.
