Helpful Reminders & Information

Communication

To help keep yourself up to date with all the nursery information please ensure you have access to the **Seesaw App**.

There will be weekly learning updates from both the Rainbow Room and the Little Stars.

We also send out regular text messages via Groupcall.

It is therefore essential that we hold an up-to-date contact number for all parents/carers.

Change of Clothes

In the event of staff having to change your child it would be better for your child if they had a complete change of their **own** clothes.

All children must therefore have a change of clothes with them at nursery. These can be kept at nursery in a bag on their peg.

If your child is given a change of clothes from the nursery can you please ensure the items are washed and returned to nursery as soon as possible. We have very little spare clothes at the moment!

If your child is wearing nappies then spare nappies and wipes should also be kept in their bags. The nursery staff will let you know when they require more.

Voluntary Contributions

Voluntary Contributions are £2.00 per week.

These can be paid weekly or termly.

From Monday 15th April until the Summer holidays is 11 weeks. Fees for the whole term would be £22.00.

Nursery envelopes will follow...

All fees are used to pay for resources for the nursery. Any issues or concerns please speak to a member of the nursery team.

Nursery fees are used for snack, additional art & craft resources, this term's caterpillars, etc.

Sun Awareness

Given we are now in April (and rapidly heading towards May/June):

- Staff will be explaining to the children about the need to keep safe in the sun and how to do this.
- Parents should apply sun cream to their child prior to coming to nursery.
- We do have a small amount of sun cream in nursery. Staff can give the parent or child the sun cream to be applied. Staff will encourage children to apply sun cream to themselves.
- The sun cream we are using is Boots
 Soltan Kids 50+
- It would be helpful if parents could also include a sun hat in their child's nursery bag (with their name on it please!)

Cuppa Chats

Rainbow Room

Rainbow Room cuppa chats for children returning to nursery next year will be taking place the week beginning 13th May.

Appointments can be arranged on the week beginning 6th May with your child's key worker. These can in person or via telephone, whichever is more convenient.

Little Stars

Little Stars cuppa chats will be taking place the week beginning 10th June.

Appointments can be arranged on the week beginning 3rd June with your child's key worker. These can in person or via telephone, whichever is more convenient.

Cuppa chats are a valuable opportunity to share some of your child's experiences at nursery and allows you to share home experiences and achievements.

Personal Learning Journeys (PLJs)

PLJs are a record of your child's learning and achievements during their time in nursery. They will be made up of photographs, observations and pictures/drawings. This information is collated by your child's Key Worker.

PLJs are a partnership document between nursery and home. There are 'Learning at Home' and 'Star Moments' which can be completed at home and included within your child's PLJ.

PLJs can be taken home to share (and returned to nursery) at any time during the nursery session. Please speak to your child's Key Worker to arrange.
