Helpful Reminders & Information

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<u>Communication</u>	<u>Change of Clothes</u>	
To help keep yourself up to date with all the nursery information please ensure you have access to the Seesaw App .	In the event of staff having to change your child it would be better for your child if they had a complete change of their own clothes.	
We also use the School App for Parents which you can download. We also send out regular text messages via Groupcall. It is therefore essential that we hold an up-to-date contact number for all parents/carers.	All children must therefore have a change of clothes with them at nursery. These can be kept at nursery in a bag on their peg. If your child is wearing nappies then spare nappies and wipes should also be kept in their bags. The nursery staff will let you know when they require more. Due to the changeable weather please ensure	
	you child has appropriate clothing to wear when playing outdoors at nursery.	
Outdoor Learning This term both the Rainbow Room and the Little Stars have already ventured out into the community with the Little Stars spending a morning at Wallsgreen Park and the Rainbow Room spending time at the woods as well as a community walk to the train station. The woods day for the Rainbow Room will predominately be on a Wednesday however there will be other days on which the children may venture out. Waterproof suits and wellies can be brought into the nursery and left in the cloakroom for easy access for when we do go out and about! If your child requires waterproofs please speak to a member of staff. Parents and carers are always welcome to join us for outdoor learning whether it be a community walk or a morning in the woods.
