We are a Kitbag School!



We are delighted to share that we are now an accredited Kitbag School. Kitbag is a resource used in many Fife schools and beyond to support pupils in developing their emotional wellbeing. Kitbag is a multi-sensory resource that helps children and young people discover ways to talk about their feelings and share their thoughts in a safe place. It works well in pairs and small groups with or without adult supervision depending on the situation.

Working with Kitbag, children go at their own pace and are encouraged to work on many levels – physical, emotional, cognitive and behavioural. Regular use helps children become better able to deal with the challenges of everyday life.
