

## Donibristle Primary School Standards and Quality Report 2024-25



Context of the School				
Demographic	Donibristle Primary School is a non-denominational school, open plan by design, serving the west of the coastal town of Dalgety Bay.			
	The present role is approximately 375; 341 pupils in school and 34 children enrolled in the nursery. There are 13 classes across P1-7. The associated secondary school is Inverkeithing High School. This will change to Caledonia High School in August 2026.			
	23.6% of learners in school have an additional support need. This is lower than the national average. We have a team of pupil support assistants who work in classes to support a wide range of needs.			
	The percentage of pupils entitled to free school meals is 1.9%. This continues to be below the national average and is for children in P6 and P7 who are eligible for free school meals.			
	School attendance as of 30 <sup>th</sup> April 2025 was 95.62%, an increase from 95.18% in 2023/24 but narrowly missing our stretch target of 96.1% The SIMD profile is 9.4 with 84% of learners in SIMD 9 and 10. The PEF allocation for this session was £14,700.

Our vision 'Work Together, Learn Together, SHINE Together' promotes a culture of teamwork at all levels. All staff use these regularly and our achievements system is based on the school values.  The current school aims are; • As a school we recognise the strengths and talents of each pupil. • As a staff, we aim to work with all partners, e.g., parents/carers and outside agencies to create an ethos of achievement, offering high quality learning experiences which involve learners in the process, enabling each pupil to attain the highest standards possible. • We value diversity, promoting social inclusion to close the gap whilst meeting the needs of the individual within an environment where everyone is equal.
