SCHOOL UNIFORM

The following guidance was agreed after consultation with our pupils and school staff.

As a school we want to instil a sense of pride in being part of the Duloch learning community and therefore seek to promote a smart and uniformed dress code which encourages a positive ethos and sense of belonging to the school.

We believe that wearing full school dress also promotes:

- self-discipline and the fostering of positive attitudes to school
- · improved security within school and on excursions
- reduction in bullying and victimisation from peer pressure to wear fashion items
- · assistance for parents in terms of economic and practical issues

It is expected that parents/carers will give full backing to the school in promoting the wearing of correct school uniform. All pupils should take a pride in identifying with the school. Expectations about student dress apply to attendance at sports fixtures and excursions organised by the school or where a pupil is representing the school. If any of our families require support, in purchasing school uniform, please contact the school office and we will be happy to help.

We are a tie promoting school and would encourage all pupils to come to school wearing our school tie.

- ▶ P1 ties and Senior ties are kindly gifted by the school parent council at the start of P1 and P7.
- Elasticated ties are also available to buy.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

The following list details ACCEPTABLE items of wear within school:


- school tie
- White or purple shirt/polo shirt
- plain black/purple cardigan/jumper/tank top
- black or grey skirt/trousers/knee-length shorts
- black or grey pinafore/purple gingham summer dress
- Duloch tartan pinafore or shorts
- purple/white/black socks or tights
- **plain black** school shoes/boots/trainers



Where possible, please keep socks/tights in keeping with school colours.

The following examples are NOT ACCEPTABLE items of wear within school:

- caps
- football colours/tops
- jeans of any colour/style
- coloured/hooded/zip tops
- brightly coloured tights
- coloured shoes/boots/trainers



During your child's P7 year, they will have the opportunity to purchase a leavers' hoodie for their final term of primary school.

All items of clothing should be clearly labelled with your child's name.

PE KIT

The Scottish Government recognises the positive impact physical education can have on a pupil's health, educational attainment and life chances and that it can form a key element of a school's plan to deliver the broad health and wellbeing outcomes and experiences contained within Curriculum for Excellence.

This includes a commitment that every school pupil in Scotland will benefit from at least two hours per week of physical education in primary school and therefore we would appreciate your support in ensuring your child has a PE kit.

All kits should be stored in a bag and hung on pegs in cloakroom areas. PE kit should be left in school at <u>all</u> times and taken home during holiday periods.

GYM kit

- plain t-shirt/long sleeved top (with or without school badge)
- Plain shorts/jogging bottoms
- plain trainers/plimsols
- Pupils are welcome to wear their house colours.
- Pupils may wish to bring an additional layer of clothing/spare shoes for outdoor gym, class teachers will make parents aware of which days gym will be outdoors.

Long hair should be tied back.

All jewellery should be removed.
