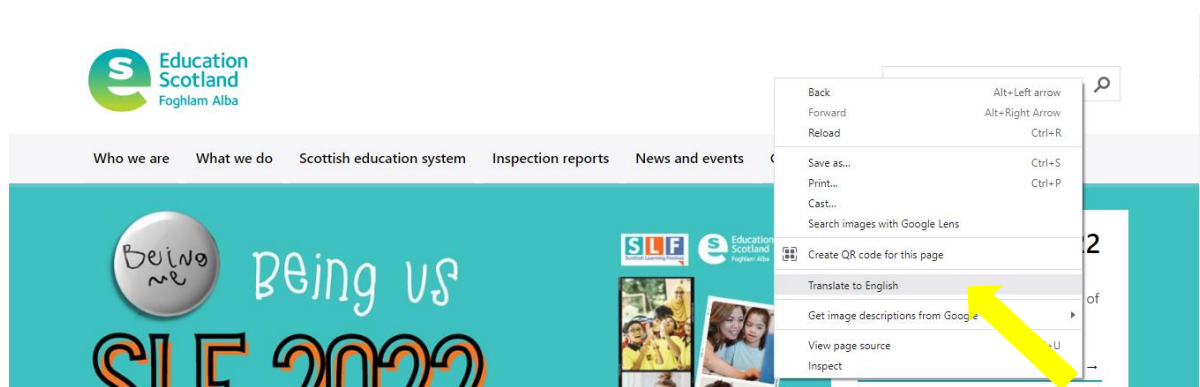


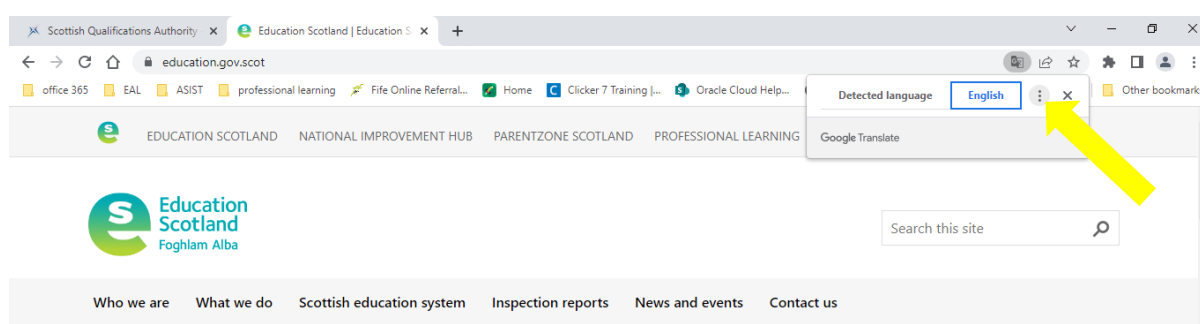
How to translate a webpage in Google Chrome and Microsoft Edge

How to translate a webpage in Google Chrome and Microsoft Edge

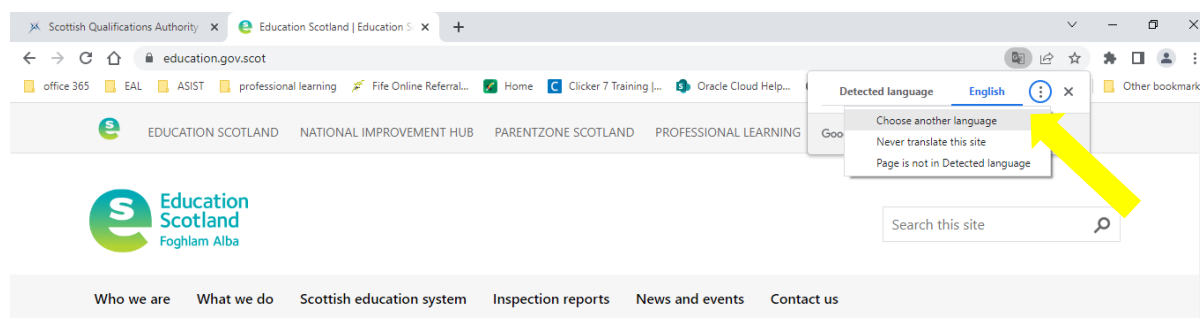
1. Open the website in Google Chrome or Microsoft Edge and **right click** on the blank space of the page and choose **Translate to English** from the pop-up menu.



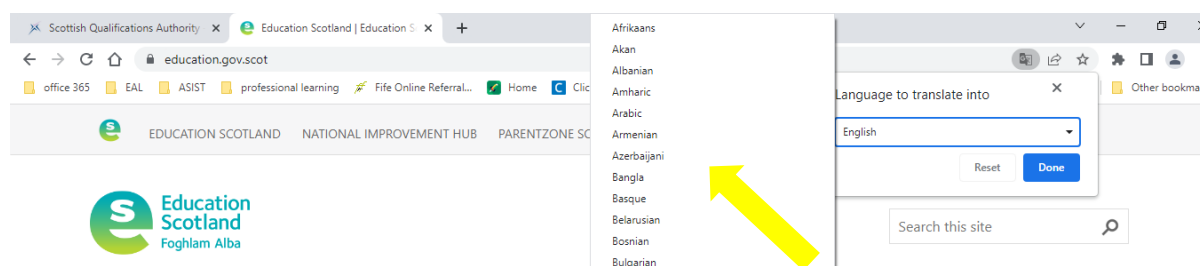
2. In the pop-up menu at the top of the page choose ellipsis (•••).



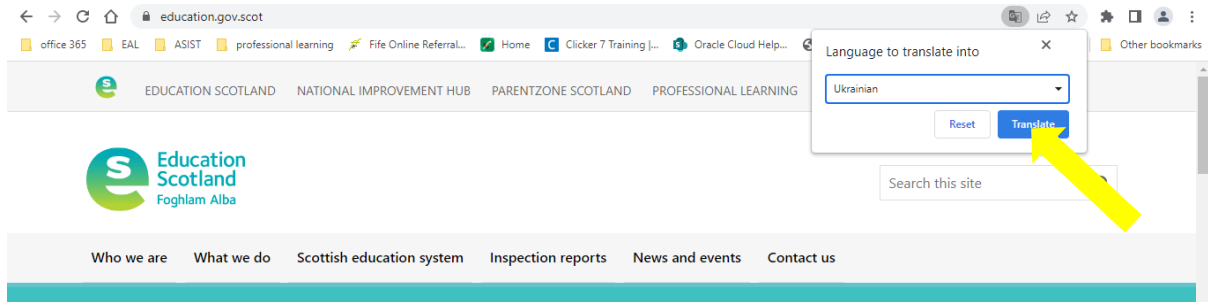
3. Select **Choose another language**.



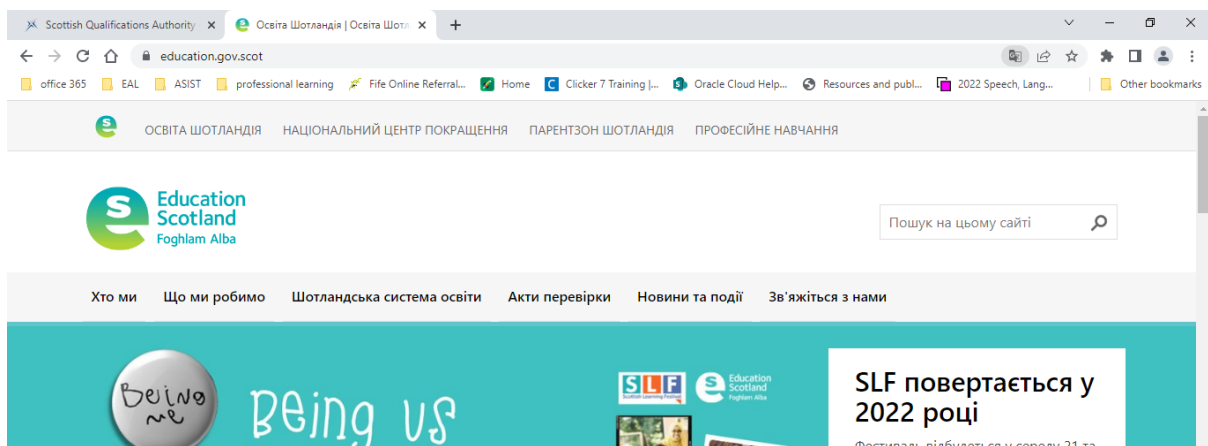
4. Select the language you want to use from the pop-up list. (In this case- Ukrainian)



5. Confirm your choice by clicking on the **Translate** button.



6. Congratulations! Your webpage has been translated 😊



If you move from the original translated webpage, your browser will display text on the new one in English again. Your browser, however, will remember the new language setting. To have the translated version on your screen again you will need to repeat steps 1 & 2 and then choose the saved language from the pop-up menu.
